08 February: Feast Day of St Josephine Bakhita, International Day of Prayer & Awareness Against Human Trafficking

30 July: World Day Against Trafficking in Persons

A UN day to raise awareness of HTMS and call for effort to strengthen prevention, identify and support victims, and end impunity.

18 October: Anti-Slavery Day

The week of anti-slavery day is marked as Anti-Slavery Week and HTMS organisations will hold events, webinars and awareness activities throughout the week.

02 December: International Day for the Abolition of Slavery

This day marks the adoption of the *United Nations Convention for the Suppression of the Traffic in Persons and of the Exploitation of the Prostitution of Others*. The day focuses on eradicating contemporary forms of slavery.
